1. For a pass, a candidate is required to obtain atleast 30% marks in each paper and 36% in the total aggregate in theory, and 40% marks in External Examination and Internal Assessment of Practice Teaching separately.

2. Theory-I Division-50% (360 marks or above); II Division-48% (288 to 359 marks); Pass Class 36% (216 to 287) marks.

3. Practice-I Division-50% (180 marks or above); II Division-48% (144 to 179 marks); Pass Class 40% (120 to 143 marks).

4. For a pass in special paper candidates are required to obtain a minimum of 30% marks.

5. Marks written with * against a paper denotes failure in that paper.

6. Application for scrutiny of marks and/or re-valuation of answer-book as permissible under the rules, should be made to the Dy. Registrar (Secrecy) on the prescribed form alongwith requisite fee within 30 days from the date of declaration of result.
